Transportation Fund – Maximize revenue – no appeal planned at this time

Bus Replacement Fund – Buy 10 buses in 2012 – used to **neutralize PBDS** 

Special Ed. Preschool Fund – state revenue only-now a part of the GF formula

  - Resolution to lower appropriations in the CPF
  - ♦ Hearing for Additional Appropriation Rainy Day has become part of the normal budgeting process-no longer requires a separate hearing.

NEW 2012 – I just received memo from DLGF on July 6 with some new and disturbing information about the Bus Replacement fund. There was new legislation this year that would establish a maximum levy beginning 2012. I have that calculation from DLGF and it may not be very favorable to the district for several reasons.

It appears that DLGF may be looking at and discontinuing the practice that has been used in the past to neutralize the impact of the pension bond payments. If the past practice is no longer allowed, we will be looking at dealing with a \$1.5 million financial issue.
