After the student has completed the application process (parent and student forms), the final selection of students will be based on the evaluation of their portfolios and try-out assignments, (as described in the packet) and past performance.

2. PORTFOLIO – To aid in the selection, please include five examples of your work. A portfolio is a continuing record of your artistic development. Think of it as a way to chart your progress as an artist. Fill it in with examples of your best work. Show a variety of work such as drawings, paintings, graphic designs, printmaking, photographs or slides, sculpture and 3-D designs and selections from your sketchbook. If you have any questions about what to include, check with your art teacher.

DO NOT include copies of others' artwork or work done from a kit.
