

## Subject: Resq Health & Safety Training offers affordable American Heart Association (AHA) cardiopulmonary resuscitation/automated external defibrillator (CPR/AED) certification tailored to the needs of educators in the state of Indiana.

Pursuant to Indiana Code § 20-28-5-3, all Indiana teaching and administrator license applicants (including applicants for renewal of an existing teaching or administrative license) must be trained and certified by the AHA, or a similar organization, in the proper administration of CPR/AED and the Heimlich Maneuver. In response to this requirement, we have formed a partnership with Resq Health & Safety Training to provide you this certification at the discounted price of **\$30.90 per person** through December, 2016. Beginning January 2017, the cost will be \$35.00 per person.

In an effort to make the certification process as convenient as possible, we have established a series of training sessions to be held at the **H. Dean Evans Community and Education Center**, 8550 Woodfield Crossing Blvd, Indianapolis, IN 46240. Classes will be held on the **2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month** (exception – no class November 8, 2016) through August, 2017!
