

# **Q & A Information for** Washington Township Schools

# Community

#### Question: What are the most significant facility concerns with secondary schools?

#### Answer:

- Safety and Security of the buildings
  - Secured entries and security cameras in the buildings
  - Student lockers are frequently broken and are so outdated that parts are no longer available
  - Bleachers are broken, not handicapped accessible, and not as secure as desired
  - A significant number of areas of the buildings are not handicapped accessible
  - Corridors or hallways are too narrow as a result of classroom doors opening into the hallways and lockers loaded on each side of hallway
  - A lack of storage areas in certain buildings resulting in items being stored in hallways
- Healthy Learning Environments
  - Repurposed spaces that were not designed as traditional classroom spaces that are now being utilized as classrooms are not conducive to effective instruction
  - Performing arts spaces that do not meet industry standards
  - Inadequate sound systems in all large gathering spaces
  - Classrooms are significantly smaller than industry standards
  - The middle schools have not been renovated in 34 years resulting in a lot of the floor covering and wall covering needing to be replaced
  - Heating and cooling systems are insufficient and inefficient
  - Roofs in certain buildings are in need of significant repairs
- Capacity
  - Small group intervention or support areas are almost non-existent
  - Clinics are small size and do not have the necessary furniture to accommodate the number of students served
  - Student furniture needs to be updated to address small classroom sizes
  - Conference room space and teacher meeting space is limited
  - The small size of our cafeterias presents significant challenges
  - Parking is not sufficient for extracurricular activities and traffic flow at drop off and dismissal is inadequate
