

MSDWT Teacher Evaluation Information for Teachers Using NWEA Primary/Secondary Measure

Determining Students that Met or Exceeded the Target

When determining the number of students that met projected growth. Teachers should include all students whose projected growth falls within the standard error of observed growth.

At the bottom of the teacher's NWEA Achievement Status and Growth Summary Report, there is a legend that shows a symbol, that when displayed next to a "Yes" or "No" on the report next to a student's name, indicates that the growth falls within standard error.

When determining the number of Students Meeting Growth Target for the spreadsheet, follow this rule:

No[†] = Yes
Yes = Yes
Yes[‡] = Yes
No = No
