### Acceptable Disciplinary Documentation includes one of the following:

- Nonresident Discipline Form (from the MSDWT website) completed and signed by an administrator, counselor, or school official on official school or school district letterhead.
- Statement from an administrator, counselor, or school official on official school or school district letterhead.
- Affidavit signed by an administrator, counselor, or school official.

In submitting this application, I am indicating that I understand the conditions of possible enrollment of my child as a nonresident student in the Metropolitan School District of Washington Township. I understand I am responsible for transportation of my child to and from school unless otherwise mandated by state or federal law. I understand that my child may be able to ride a district bus if I transport the child to a pick-up point of a designated route, providing there is space available on that bus. Further, I understand that I could be billed an additional amount for the cost of transportation, if the district chooses to bill for transportation. I understand that final approval of this application is subject to approval by the district. I understand my child's continuing nonresident status may be denied should he/she receive disciplinary consequences while an MSDWT student, consistent with the infractions listed above as potential reasons for denial of an initial application for nonresident status.

I understand, in the event that MSDWT finds that any information provided on my student's behalf is false or misleading, this application may be denied or my student may lose nonresident status in the MSDWT.

I agree to adhere to the following timeline should nonresident status be granted:

December 15, 2016 - Deadline for Applications.

January 9, 2017 – MSDWT will conduct random selection of students if applications exceed capacity for any grade level.

January 16, 2017 - MSDWT will notify families of nonresident application status on or after this date.

The District will annually review the capacity and number of applications. If, by February 1, sufficient capacity exists within grade levels, the District may elect to re-open the application process for nonresident students.
