### **Draft Future Plans for the South End of Central Campus**

As you are aware the LOBER neighborhood (Lincoln Blvd, Oakland Rd, Brent Ave, Ecole St, Englewood Rd, and Rosemead Ln. - LOBER) meeting that was previously scheduled for April 9, 2020 was cancelled due to COVID-19 and the subsequent stay at home order by the governor. We understand the importance of staying connected by continuing our conversations regarding MSD Washington Township's construction referendum planning. Therefore, we are scheduling a virtual meeting for Tuesday, April 28, 2020 at 5:00 PM for anyone interested in the draft plans for the south end of central campus. During this meeting, we plan to share information regarding draft proposals impacting the south end of central campus.

Information to include:

- Transportation Center & Bus Storage Draft Plans
  - Relocation plans of the bus storage on central campus
    - 1. Rationale on why suggested options have been ruled out
  - Details on buses that would be added to the apx. 80 that are currently stored on the south end of the property
  - Acoustical data findings from sound engineers and noise barrier concepts
  - How proposed improvements create positive environmental impact
  - Traffic Impact Analysis
- Operations Center Draft Plans
  - Rationale for use of Northview
    - 1. Assessment & cost analysis findings
  - District services that would be a part of the operations center
  - Student & community programs that would remain at the existing Northview facility
- Site Construction Draft Plans
  - 1. Site details from Schmidt Architects
    - Draft preliminary renderings and site maps
    - Bus, car, pedestrian traffic & activity zones
    - How re-organization positively impacts safety
    - How these improvements positively impact the future of North Central campus areas
    - Draft phasing/construction schedules
- Feedback
  - Responses to frequently asked questions
  - Opportunity for additional questions and comments

We appreciate your patience as we have spent the last few weeks focused on the public health crisis and transitioning to At-Home learning.
