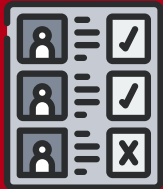

 Since returning to the classroom amidst the global pandemic, students in Washington Township Schools are demonstrating notable gains.

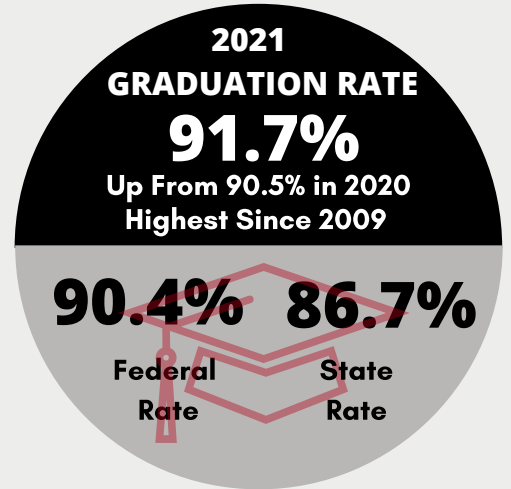
IMPROVED ATTENDANCE

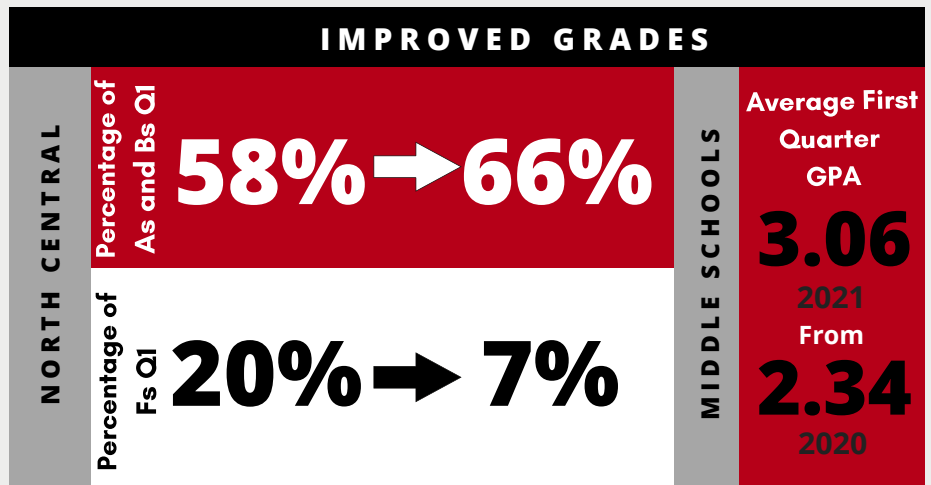
In Some Schools From One Year Ago

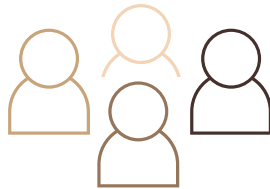
