Homework is neither a substitute for classroom instruction nor a punitive measure. Homework may include additional practice exercises, reading materials, incomplete classroom activities, or independent project work related to the subject. Students are expected to complete all assigned homework.

Homework should fulfill the following objectives:

1. to review, remediate, or extend classroom learning;
2. to teach students responsibility and time-management skills;
3. to improve study habits; and
4. to provide the opportunity for independent learning.
