



PARENT AND STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES REGARDING DIABETES AT SCHOOL

Diabetes is a complex and ever-changing diagnosis that requires parents, students, school nurses, and school employees to be continually prepared. To ensure safety and optimal learning environment for student with diabetes, the school provides the following:

- General Training emailed to all teachers each semester.
- Specific training emails to teachers with students with diabetes each semester.
- In person training to primary teachers of elementary students or students with special needs that have diabetes.
- Yearly training for all school nurses.
- Quick Reference Emergency Plan given to transportation yearly.
- Volunteer Health Aid (VHA) training each year to school employees who are willing to assist with students with diabetes.
- Additional training as deemed necessary by the district nurse.
- VHA or school nurse at all school sponsored after school activities on school campus unless the parent chooses to attend the activity.

To properly care for your student and to promote healthy life skills, we ask that you and your student adhere to the following:

- Provide a Diabetic Medical Management Plan (DMMP) yearly prior to the beginning of school.
- Provide all supplies needed by your student for daily care (determined by DMMP)
- Provide all emergency supplies (determined by DMMP).
- **Carry a sugar source at all times.** The school cannot provide simple carbohydrates to your students. Students with diabetes and parents must be aware that it is their responsibility to have an emergency bag available at all times including fire drills, lockdowns, field trips and after school activities.
- Sign all required forms for students to possess and self-administer medication or treatment while at school.
- Review and sign the Individualized Health Plan (IHP).
- Attend a medical conference each year with a school nurse to review the IHP and provide supplies.

I have reviewed the above school responsibilities and personal responsibilities. I agree to provide the supplies needed by my student. I will discuss with my student the importance of always having emergency supplies available on him/her/themselves.
