#### **Bidding Instructions and Information:**

Bids shall be properly and completely executed on Indiana State Board of Accounts, Form 96, Revised 2013. Bidders shall also complete the Supplementary Bid Forms (included in the contract documents). Submit all original Bid Information and two (2) complete copies. Complete the entire Bid Form(s), including the Non-Collusion Affidavit, and the Bidders Financial Statement information as part of Indiana Form 96.

Bidders are required to include a Bid Bond or certified check in the amount of 10% of their Bid Price. Bidder receiving awards shall be required to provide acceptable surety in the form of a Performance Bond and Labor and Materials Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract. Include the cost of all bonds and insurance in the bid amount.

Each bid must be accompanied by a signed and completed Non-Discrimination Affidavit (or MBE-1) in accordance with any applicable Minority Business Participation Policy and Rules.
